City of Citronelle Transportation Plan Pursuant to the Rebuild Alabama Act (RAA)

The Alabama Legislature in Act. No. 2019-2 adopted the Rebuild Alabama Act (RAA). The Rebuild Alabama Act provides for an allocation among the municipalities of the state on the basis of the ratio of population of each municipality to the total population of all municipalities of the state. A portion of the additional taxes levied under the Act is to be used for transportation infrastructure, improvement, preservation and maintenance of roads and bridges, matching funds for federal road or bridge projects. (Reference AL.ACT NO 2019-2) The Act provides that the municipal governing body of the City of Citronelle shall adopt an annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31 which shall provide a specific project(s) for which expenditures are intended to be made in the next fiscal year and shall be based upon an estimate of the revenues anticipated from the fund.

State distribution of gas tax funds and diesel funds are held in a separate account for the City of Citronelle. The City of Citronelle anticipates the Fiscal Year 2021 State distributions may be higher than in 2020. It was estimated the City would receive \$24,204.00. To date the total distribution for Gasoline and Diesel tax is \$17,791.39. Funds not expended will be rolled over to next fiscal year.

The City of Citronelle is working with Civil Southeast, LLC. to present projects for the CDBG grant and other grant and loan opportunities with USDA and potential Federal grants. Funds will be used as a local match for future grant opportunities.

The City anticipates expending funds received pursuant to the Act for cold patch and rock mix to repair pot holes on streets within City limits in the amount of \$3,000.00 from Mobile Asphalt Company in Mobile, AL.

The Rebuild Alabama Act Transportation Plan is hereby adopted and approved this 13th day of August 2020.
